



Romans 10:9, "That if you shall confess with your mouth the Master Yahshua, and shall believe in your heart that Yahweh has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved."

Yahweh sent His Son Yahshua. Yahshua taught us about Yahweh and Yahshua died for our sins. Then Yahweh raised Yahshua from the dead and set Yahshua above everything in the Universe.

Do you know what a master is?

A master is someone who is in charge. The one who has the power and authority like a ruler or a king.



When you confess that Yahshua is your Master, you are saying that He is your ruler and king. You are bearing witness that He has the power and authority over you.



The Bible says that when you say Yahshua is your Master and you mean it, making Him Master over your life, then you will be saved. You will have eternal life and live forever in Yahweh's Kingdom.



Go Ahead, make Yahshua your Master. A good way to do this is to say a prayer to Yahweh. Tell Yahweh you make Yahshua your Master and believe He raised His Son Yahshua from the dead.

dead.

Thank you for giving me eternal life in your kingdom and for leading me in life through your Son Yahshua.



That was easy!

When you make Yahshua your Master you get born of Yahweh's spirit. That spirit from Yahweh will never leave you. It is now part of you.

Now look what the Bible tells us in Joshua 1:9:

Joshua 1:9, "Have not I commanded you? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for Yahweh your Elohim is with you wherever you go."

The Bible also tells us that when we have Yahshua as our Master and King that Yahweh's Son Yahshua is in us and with us.²

Look what Yahshua said in John 14:27.

John 14:27, Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world gives, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.



You can have peace in your heart. Even when bad things are happening around you; you don't need to be troubled or afraid because Yahweh and Yahshua are always with you.

Always remember that Yahweh and His Son Yahshua are with you and in you all the time.
